Date: 30/06/2023 Organised by IQAC






**Objective:** To organise an informative session to enable the teachers to get oriented with the National Education Policy – NEP 2020.

## Seminar on International Mother Language Day



# Seminar on the Need for Constitution in a Democracy Date: 26/11/2022 Organised by IQAC & Department of Political Science





**Objective:** To disseminate knowledge about the fundamental values, philosophy and philosophy on which Indian Constitution is created.

Organised by Department of Bengali, Baruipur College



Organised By Baruipur college, Library and Information Science Professionals Association of Bengal and Shimurali Sachnandan College of Education




**Objective:** To organize a webinar to understand the importance of virtual education in the time of the Covid-19 pandemic.

Organised By IQAC and CCC, Baruipur College






**Objective:** To make the students aware of obtaining necessary skills and entrepreneurial approach in the everchanging IT sector.

Date: 19.02.2020 Organised By IQAC and CCC, Baruipur College






**Objective:** To organize an expert-led session covering a spectrum of topics crucial for students aspiring to excel in the realm of information technology and computer science.



Date: 06.02.2020 Organised By IQAC



Organised By Department of Journalism, Baruipur College




**Objective:** To conduct industry academia interaction in the field of media and to train the students in media content generation.

# Seminar on Vidyasagar in History Date: 26.09.2019 Organised By Department of History, Baruipur College




**Objective:** To organize a seminar to explore the multifaceted legacy of Vidyasagar and to shed light on his pivotal role in shaping historical narratives.
